1. Introduction

This Cookie Policy explains how ComIO.Studio (“we”, “our”, or “us”) uses cookies and similar technologies. We are committed to protecting your privacy and giving you control over your data. This policy explains what cookies are, which ones we use, and how you can manage your preferences.

2. What are cookies and similar technologies?

Cookies are small text files that websites place on your device to store information. They help websites remember your preferences, understand how you use the site, and provide a better experience. Cookies can be:

- **Session cookies** — deleted when you close your browser
 - **Persistent cookies** — remain on your device until they expire or you delete them
 - **First-party cookies** — set by the website you’re visiting
 - **Third-party cookies** — set by other services the website uses

3. Desktop Application

ComIO.Studio as a desktop application **does not use cookies**. All application data (configurations, logs, chat history, macros) is stored locally on the User’s device.

4. comio.studio Website

4.1 Essential Cookies

Our website uses **Cloudflare** as its CDN and security provider. Cloudflare may set the following cookies necessary for proper operation:

These cookies are **essential** for website security and protection against malicious traffic. They cannot be disabled without significantly impacting your use of the site.

Cloudflare cookies: - Are not used for tracking users for advertising purposes - Do not collect personally identifiable information - Are set automatically by Cloudflare infrastructure - Details: cloudflare.com/privacypolicy

4.2 Analytics Cookies

We currently **do not use** any third-party analytics tools on comio.studio. We do not collect data about user behavior, track sessions, or profile visitors.

If we implement analytics tools in the future, we will update this Cookie Policy and, where required, obtain your consent.

4.3 Advertising Cookies

We **do not use** advertising or tracking cookies. We do not share cookie data with third parties for advertising purposes.

5. Your Cookie Choices

5.1 Browser Controls

You can control cookies through your browser settings:

- **Chrome:** Settings → Privacy and security → Cookies and other site data
- **Firefox:** Settings → Privacy & Security → Cookies and Site Data
- **Safari:** Preferences → Privacy → Manage Website Data

- **Edge:** Settings → Cookies and site permissions

Note: Blocking all cookies may prevent certain website features from functioning properly.

5.2 Specific Opt-Out

- **Essential cookies (Cloudflare):** Cannot be disabled while using our site — they are necessary for operation and security.
 - **Analytics cookies:** Not used — no opt-out needed.
 - **Advertising cookies:** Not used.

We follow privacy-by-design principles:

- We minimize cookie usage
 - We don't use tracking or advertising cookies
 - We don't sell or share cookie data with third parties
 - All cookies are transmitted securely over HTTPS
 - The only cookies used are essential Cloudflare cookies (bot protection)
